ABOUT

WWIB is a not for profit organisation run by local business women in the Wollondilly.

As part of our commitment to the Community, we are now offering some lucky women in the Wollondilly area, funds to either, start a business, start training, or return to the workforce.

The successful applicants will receive financial support for training, mentoring and transport costs in the form of vouchers that are redeemable through Wollondilly Businesses.

These will include Business Planning, Hands on Training through WWIB Members, Personal Presentation, Life Coach, Dressing for Business etc

Fund Allocation

The successful applicant/s will be eligible assistance as listed below

No cash will handed out at any time.

Funding will be given in voucher form, to be spent at participating businesses throughout the WWIB network, for training courses only, not purchases, unless otherwise approved by WWIB committee. eg the applicant may need office supplies to start a business.

The successful applicants will be determined on case by case merit.

Where transport is required WWIB may purchase petrol cards or public transport cards for use by the applicant.

An applicant applying for a TAFE course may have some or all of the course fees paid by WWIB.

WWIB Mentoring Fund will not pay for stock for a shop.

All applications must be true and correct and WWIB reserves the right to withdraw the funding at any given time.

Woman Returning to Work or Training for Work

The applicant must show that:

- They reside in the Wollondilly area.
- They have a financial need to apply for the assistance (may be on Benefits etc)
- They have a physical need for assistance (may have recovered from an illness or have a disability, have a child with a disability)
- They are willing to work hard, follow all directives and follow through with all training.
- All applicants must disclose any other funding that they may receive for a similar purpose eg Newstart paying for a TAFE course etc

Woman Opening a Business

The applicant must show that they :

- Are a resident of the Wollondilly wishing to open a business in the Wollondilly OR
- A person wishing to open a business in the Wollondilly
- Have a 'practical' idea for a business like hairdresser, retail outlet, Café etc
- Will use all resources offered by WWIB, or suitable alternatives (eg recognised educational facility)
